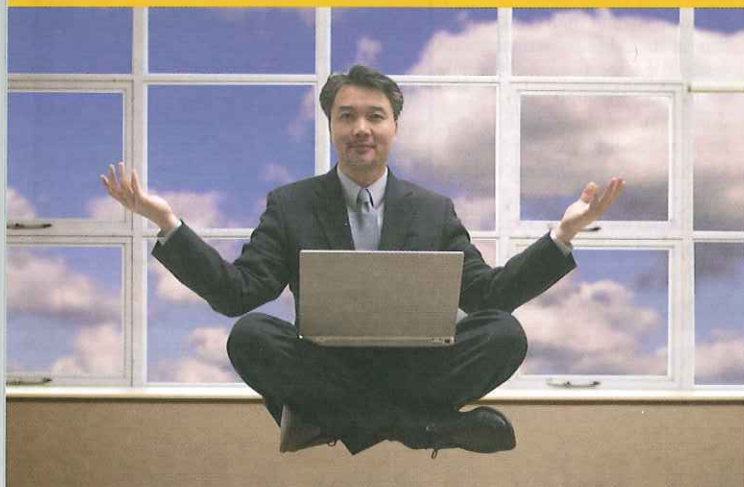
■ The Greater Madison (Wis.) Convention & Visitors Bureau hired **Diane Morgenthaler** as director of marketing.
